STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the People's Ferry Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1885, c. 495, § 10, repealed and replaced. Section 10 of chapter 495 of the private and special laws of 1885, as enacted by chapter 94 of the private and special laws of 1919, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 10. Maintenance of landings by other companies. No other ferry or steam or power boat line operating between Portland and the islands in Casco Bay shall make or maintain a landing place on Peak's Island, Great Diamond Island, Little Diamond Island, Long Island and Chebeague Island without the written consent of the public utilities commission; but nothing herein shall be construed to interfere with or impair the existing vested rights of any other transportation company.'
