COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 838, L. D. 877, Bill "An Act  
Relating to the Town of Hampden School  
District." (Emergency)

Amend said Bill by striking out the word "hazzard" in the  
3rd line of the 4th paragraph of the Emergency Preamble and  
inserting in place thereof the word 'hazard'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the punctuation  
and words ", but in the event said total number of votes cast  
does not equal or exceed said 20% of the total vote for all  
candidates for governor cast in said town at the next pre-  
vious gubernatorial election another special meeting shall  
be called and the question again resubmitted to the voters  
in the same manner as above set forth" appearing in the  
last 6 lines of the next to the last paragraph of said Bill  
on page 2.
