**RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Gardiner.**

**City of Gardiner; reimbursed. Resolved:** That the sum of \$576.34 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the city of Gardiner, to reimburse said city for ADC paid to the state in the case of Doris Payton, a non-settled case; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The case of Doris Payton was accepted as an ADC case by the city of Gardiner through error. It was discovered in 1952 that this case was a state general relief case and had been accepted as such by the Department of Health and Welfare. Therefore, the city of Gardiner is asking for reimbursement.
