RESOLVE, in Favor of Cary Plantation.

Cary plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Cary plantation the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, to aid in the reconstruction of the bridge, under the Bridge Act, which spans Meduxnekeag stream, located on the road which connects U. S. route No. 1 with the town of Hodgdon; the above sum to be the plantation's share of the cost of reconstruction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state highway commission is working on an estimate of the cost of this bridge. The purpose of this resolve is to have the state assume Cary Plantation's share of the cost, as the plantation cannot assume that much expenditure.
