RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Linneus.

Town of Linneus; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$700 appropriated in favor of the town of Linneus by the 95th legislature for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, for the repair of Drew's Lake road, so called, running along the northerly shore of said lake, commencing at the Back Linneus road, so called, and continuing to the Pine Grove, so called; be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended to aid in repairing Drew's Hill road, so called, beginning at New Limerick town line and extending in a southerly direction to South Oakfield road, so called.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is desired by the town of Linneus to have the money appropriated by this resolve available to repair the Drew's Hill road.
