## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Daily Bag Limit on Rabbits in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 95, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 95 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'During the open season it shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, take, kill or have in possession more than 4 rabbits taken, shot or killed in any one day and not more than 8 rabbits so shot or killed in possession at any one time, except that in Somerset county and in York county it shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, take, kill or have in possession at any + one time more than 2 rabbits.'
