STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Daily Bag Limit on Partridge or Grouse and Pheasants in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding before the last sentence of the 2nd paragraph thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'In York county no person during the open season shall have in possession in any one day more than 2 partridge and 2 pheasants or in any one open season for partridge or grouse more than 18 partridge or 12 pheasants.'
