STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting with Bow and Arrow in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 96-A, amended. Section 96-A of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 96-A. Open season. There shall be an annual open season on deer in the counties of Franklin, Kennebec and Somerset from October 1st to October 15th, inclusive, for the purpose of hunting deer with bow and arrow only.'
