IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Open Red River, Aroostook County, to Fishing.

Red river; opened to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Red river in Aroostook county from the mouth of St. Froid lake to Red river falls, so called, to fishing.
