**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Cathance Stream
in Washington County.**

Fish screen at outlet of Cathance stream, Washington county. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game for installing a fish screen on the Cathance Outlet where the stream crosses the Marion road, in Washington county; provided, however, that the Quoddy Rod and Gun Club shall assume all liability for the maintenance of said screen and for keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The members of the local Quoddy Rod and Gun Club of Eastport are greatly interested to see that a screen is built on the Cathance Outlet where the stream crosses the Marion road, thus making a place to give the salmon and trout a chance to spawn.
