**RESOLVE, Providing for Dam and Fish Screen at the Outlet of Lake
Embden in the Town of Embden.**

Fish screen and dam installed at outlet of Lake Embden. Resolved:
That the sum of \$3,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game for installing a dam and fish screen at the outlet of lake Embden in the town of Embden, in the county of Somerset; provided, however, that said dam and screen shall not be installed at the outlet of lake Embden until the Embden lake improvement association shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves, and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent free running of water through the same; and provided further that the state shall be liable for only one half the cost of said screen and dam.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The fish screen at the outlet of Lake Embden is greatly needed.
