STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Stonington.

Construction of a sea wall; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$10,000 from the general fund of the state in favor of the town of Stonington for the construction of a sea wall on the ocean front for the purpose of a public dock; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$30,000 from the general highway fund in favor of the town of Stonington for filling the area between the present shore and the sea wall.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sea wall will permit a public dock and fill is necessary between the shore and the sea wall for additional land to be used by the town for parking areas and streets.
