STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Pauper Settlement of Parents of Children Receiving Aid to Dependent Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 82, § 9, amended. The last sentence of section 9 of chapter 82 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 127 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'During the period that a dependent child is receiving aid under the pertinent provisions of chapter 22 of the rewised statutes, such dependent child and the parent or parents from whom such child derives his settlement shall not acquire or lose a settlement.'
