STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge and Recorder of the Waldo County Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 12, § 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2 of chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by chapter 114 of the private and special laws of 1945, and by chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said judge shall receive a salary of \$1,750 \$3,000 per year and said recorder shall receive a salary of \$200 \$2,400 per year for all services in criminal and civil cases, to be paid from the treasury of the county of Waldo in monthly payments on the last day of each month.'
