STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Rental for Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 14, amended. The 1st sentence of section 14 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by chapter 33 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The town of Millinocket may, if it shall so vote, at any regularly held town meeting, provide a suitable court room in said Millinocket, conveniently situated and appropriately fitted up and furnished, in which to hold said court, and keep the same in proper condition for use, and it shall be deemed and denominated the court room, though used also for other purposes if approved by the judge, for which there shall be paid from the county of Penobscot, as rental, the sum of \$750 \$1,000 annually, in quarterly payments.'
