STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Caribou Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1905, c. 352, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 57 of the private and special laws of 1945, which amended chapter 352 of the private and special laws of 1905, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$2,500 \$3,500 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1905, c. 352, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 57 of the private and special laws of 1945, which amended chapter 352 of the private and special laws of 1905, as amended by section 1 of chapter 159 of the private and special laws of 1951 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$1,250 \$1,800 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
