STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Town Manager of the Town of Mount Desert.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1929, c. 97, § 12, amended. Section 12 of chapter 97 of the private and special laws of 1929, as amended by section 2 of chapter 30 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 12. Salary of town manager. The town manager shall devote his entire time to his said office, and shall receive for his services a rate of compensation to be fixed by the selectmen, which rate of compensation shall not exceed the sum of \$5,000 per year, and actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties, to be paid by the town treasurer in monthly payments on the 1st day of every month.'
