STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Piscataquis Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 166, § 21, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 21 of chapter 166 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 189 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive a salary of fourteen hundred dollars **\$1,700** per year, to be taxed as a part of the costs to be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Piscataquis county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 166, § 5, amended. The last sentence of section 5 of chapter 166 of the private and special laws of 1911, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 102 of the private and special laws of 1919 and as amended by chapter 30 of the private and special laws of 1945. is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall be paid for all services as recorder of said Piscataquis

municipal court an annual salary of \$500 \$600 in quarterly payments on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year from the county treasury of Piscataquis county.
