STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Judge and Recorder of Northern Cumberland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1919, c. 48, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1919, as amended by chapter 100 of the private and special laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 16. Salary of judge and recorder. The judge of said court shall receive the salary of \$1,000 \$1,200 per year, to be paid in equal quarterly payments from the county treasury of Cumberland county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge, except as hereinbefore provided. The recorder shall receive a salary of \$200 \$400 per year, payable in the same manner as that of the judge.'
