COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 832, L. D. 948, Bill, "An Act  
to Provide for the Appointment of a  
Board of Commissioners for the Police  
and Fire Departments of the City of Saco."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Emergency  
preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out, in the referendum  
clause at the end thereof, the headnote and 1st sentence and  
inserting in place thereof the following: 'Referendum, effective  
date; certificate to secretary of state. This act shall take  
effect 90 days after adjournment of the legislature, only for  
the the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters  
of the city of Saco at the next annual city election to be held  
in March, 1954, or at a special election to be held not later  
than 4 months after the effective date of this act.'
