## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

### AN ACT Authorizing the Town of Windham to Contribute to the Rebuilding of the Dam in Little Sebago Lake.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, the dam in Little Sebago Lake in the town of Windham is in imminent danger of washing out; and

Whereas, the value of the real estate along the shores of Little Sebago Lake will be seriosuly affected if this should occur; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary for public health and safety that said dam be rebuilt; and

Whereas, the town of Gray and the members of the Little Sebago Lake Association are willing to join with the town of Windham in contributing to the rebuilding of the dam; and

Whereas, it is imperative that action be taken at the earliest possible time to prevent the disintegration of the dam; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Contribution for rebuilding dam in Little Sebago Lake authorized.** The town of Windham is hereby authorized to raise and appropriate a sum not to exceed \$1,000 for the purpose of contributing the same to the rebuilding of the dam in Little Sebago Lake located in the town of Windham.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
