RESONVE, in Favor of the Town of Gouldsboro.

Town of Gouldsboro; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953 and \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954 to compensate the town of Gouldsboro for lag in state educational subsidy under the general purpose aid law, caused by a large increase in expenditures for secondary education by the town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Heavy expenditures in education by the town of Gouldsboro was occasioned by assessments by the Flanders Bay Community School District. Since the state educational subsidy based on these expenditures will not occur until 1955 and 1956, there has been a great hardship on the town.
