## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lewis M. Mooers, of Gardiner.

Lewis M. Mooers; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$2,500 to be paid to Lewis M. Mooers, of Gardiner, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for loss incurred because of the change in location of the road which passed his filling station.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Learning that new highway 201 would by-pass his station, Mr. Mooers appealed to the state highway commission. Nothing under the present laws could be done to reimburse him. He is, therefore submitting this resolve asking that he might be reimbursed for the expense of moving his business to a new location on the new highway.
