IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Ira B. Hagan, of Ellsworth Falls, for Storage, of State Highway Equipment.

Ira B. Hagan; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$6,000 from the state highway fund, to be paid to Ira B. Hagen, of Ellsworth Falls, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for storage of state highway equipment from 1920 to 1948.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state highway commission has used the premises of Mr. Hagen for storage of state highway equipment, tar equipment, trailers, houses, crushed stone, gravel, fences, etc., since 1920 to October 2, 1948. This is a service that the highway department has recognized but is unable to pay due to a technicality of law.
