STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to State Liquor Warehouse and Wholesale Store.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 57, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 144 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The state warehouse and wholesale store shall be located in Augusta.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the working capital of the Maine state liquor commission the sum of \$325,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.
