RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry J. Deabay, of Ashland.

Henry J. Deabay; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 from the general fund to be paid to Henry J. Deabay, of Ashland, to compensate him for 29 days' service as field artillery officer in the National Guard.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1949, while waiting for federal recognition, Henry J. Deabay, of Ashland, attended drills, etc., and was all ready to leave for Camp Edwards, Mass., when he was notified that he had not passed his physical. His foot locker was on the train so he went as planned; and was acting battery commander for the 1st week at Camp, due to the captain's absence. He received no pay, so is now asking for compensation.
