Leon C. Roberts & Sons; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, paid to Leon C. Roberts & Sons, Winthrop, from the general fund of the state the sum of \$100 as reimbursement for the funeral expenses of Albert E. Houghton.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Albert E. Houghton, Mount Vernon, was a recipient of old age assistance. On March 5, 1952 a letter was written to Mr. Houghton advising him that his old age assistance was being discontinued effective March 1, 1952. Mr. Houghton died March 6, 1952 and because he was not an active recipient of old age assistance the state could not pay the funeral bill.
