STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Waterford.

Town of Waterford; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 appropriated in favor of the town of Waterford by the 89th legislature for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941; and the sum of \$500 appropriated in favor of the town of Waterford for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1946 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, by the 92nd legislature, for the rebuilding of Proctor bridge, so called, located approximately 1 mile east of North Waterford on state highway 118 leading from North Waterford to Norway, be and hereby is reappropriated to be applied to old highway 118 leading from new highway 118 to Bisbee town road — not over 2 miles.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is desired to reallocate the appropriations which were made in favor of Proctor bridge by the 89th and 92nd legislatures, and which have not been expended, to be applied to old highway 118.
