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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Waldoboro.**

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**Town of Waldoboro; money reallocated. Resolved:** That the sum of \$500 appropriated by the 95th legislature for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, in favor of the town of Waldoboro, to aid in replacing the present wooden Goose river bridge, so called, with a multi-plate culvert with necessary fill, said bridge being on route 220 between Waldoboro and Friendship; be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended for reconstruction of Mill street in said town of Waldoboro.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Bridge is being built by bond issue. Mill street is in need of reconstruction.
