STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Exhibits of Agricultural Fair Associations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 17-A, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 17-A of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 320 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The total premium payments for these exhibits shall be, at least, an amount equal to the premiums or purses paid for pulling contests at the same fair and race meet, and not less than 35% of the amount paid for purses for harness horse races conducted during the annual fair.'
