IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Pittston for Support and Medical Aid Extended to Certain Families.

Town of Pittston; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$2,583.22 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Pittston, to reimburse said town for support and medical aid extended to Homer McCullum. and family, Frank Baker and family, and Freemont Carver and family; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to an error, the bills pertaining to Homer McCullum and family and Frank Baker and family were not presented to the health and welfare department for payment. They are non-settlement cases and have been accepted by the state. Due to an error, the bill pertaining to Freemont Carver and family was paid to the town of Bowdoin; this case has since been accepted by the state.
