## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Water Used for Domestic Purposes from the Sales and Use Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 14-A, § 10, sub-§ VII-B, additional. Section 10 of chapter 14-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VII-B, to read as follows:
- 'VII-B. Water. Water used for residential purposes; provided said water shall not be exempt if, without separate watering or separate intake, the water is also used for commercial or industrial purposes.'
