**AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Water Used for Domestic Purposes
from the Sales and Use Tax.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14-A, § 10, sub-§ VII-B, additional. Section 10 of chapter 14-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VII-B, to read as follows:

‘VII-B. Water. Water used for residential purposes; provided said water shall not be exempt if, without separate watering or separate intake, the water is also used for commercial or industrial purposes.’
