HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 945, L. D. 987, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Taxation of Domestic Fowl"

Amend said Bill by striking out from the second paragraph thereof all of the underlined words and inserting in place thereof the following underlined phrase:

'provided, however, that domestic fowl being raised for sale either in the form of dressed fowl or for egg production, shall be taxed on the average amount kept on hand during the preceding year or any portion of that year; the average amount shall be determined by totaling the greatest value of the fowl on hand at any time in each month of the preceding year and dividing by twelve.'
