IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor License Credit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 57, § 56, amended. Section 56 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

‘; nor shall this section prohibit any hotel, restaurant, tavern, club or retail store from receiving normal credit for the purchase of malt liquor from a wholesaler within the state.’
