**AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Aids Employed by Sheriff in Criminal Cases.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 79, § 166, sub-§ XXX, amended.** Subsection XXX of section 166 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'XXX.** For each aid necessarily employed in criminal cases, including expenses, ~~\$~~ **\$8** a day, and in that proportion for a longer or shorter time, and 10c a mile for travel in going out and returning home, **if necessary to travel by common carrier.**'
