**AN ACT Relating to Signals by Lights or Mechanical Signal Devices on
Motor Vehicles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 19, § 107-B, amended. Section 107-B of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 301 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows :

'It shall be unlawful to operate on any highway any such motor vehicle described in section 107-A which is registered in the state and which shall have been manufactured or assembled after December 31, 1953, unless such motor vehicle be equipped with a signal lamp or lamps or mechanical signal device.'
