## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Corinna Union Academy.

Corinna Union Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$3,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by Corinna Union academy for repairs and improvements of the academy; and be it further

**Resolved:** That funds hereby appropriated shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until such time as the purposes of this resolve have been completed; and be it further

**Resolved:** That this appropriation shall be expended for the completion of the agricultural workshop at Corinna Union Academy.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1951 approximately \$1000 was appropriated to build an agricultural workshop at Corinna Union Academy. \$3,000 is needed to complete this project.
