STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Erskine Academy.

Erskine academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$12,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to improve the home economics and agricultural facilities of Erskine academy to conform with state standards.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Erskine academy, located at South China, has been confronted with an increase in enrollment of 50% during the past 6 years. It provides high school education for the towns of China, Palermo, Windsor, Whitefield and draws students from numerous other towns. An addition to the women's dormitory is needed to provide the minimum floor space of 1,500 square feet for their home economic course. This appropriation would also provide equipment for a recently completed agricultural building.
