RESOLVE, in Favor of Elizabeth Deering Moffatt, of Bath.

Elizabeth Deering Moffatt; compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$2,241 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to be paid to Elizabeth Deering Moffatt, of Bath, for loss of equipment, time and expense as a result of action taken by the department of sea and shore fisheries.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

As the result of action taken by the department of sea and shore fisheries, Mrs. Moffatt was deprived of the opportunity to fish for lobsters from August 5th, 1952. The financial loss to the present date has been \$2,241. The figure given to this date covers loss of income, loss of equipment and expense incurred so far in trying to correct the situation.
