### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Stockton Springs.

Stockton Springs; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Stockton Springs, the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, to aid in repairing the road beginning from the present state aid road on the east side of Cape Jellison and extending to the lighthouse property on Fort Point, a distance of .95 mile; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is the only road leading to the lighthouse and needs repair.
