STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of November in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Sagadahoc, Waldo **and** Washington and York. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. Section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual open season on deer in York county from November 16th to December 16th, inclusive; all the rest of the calendar year, either before or after the open season, shall be a closed season on deer in York county, except that after December 1st the balance of the season to remain open at the discretion of the commissioner.'
