STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season and Daily Bag Limit on Woodcock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 75, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 75 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual open season on woodcock from October 1st to October 31st November 15th, both days inclusive, and during the open season no person shall take or kill more than \pm 6 woodcock in any one day or have more than \pm 12 in possession at any one time.'
