STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Licenses for Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 63, sub-§ VI, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection VI of section 63 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any resident between the ages of 12 and 18 under the age of 16 years may hunt with firearms without a license if accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian an adult while in the fields or forests or on the waters or ice of the state. Any resident between the ages of 12 15 and 18 years may procure a license to hunt with firearms by filing with the clerk issuing the license the written consent of his parent or guardian.'
