AN ACT Relating to the Revocation of an Insurance Agent's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 252-L, sub-§ II, amended. The 1st sentence of subsection II of section 252-L of chapter 56 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 162 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended by repealing the 1st sentence thereof, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Before any license shall be refused, except for failure to pass a required written examination, or suspended or revoked, or the renewal thereof refused hereunder, the insurance commissioner shall give at least 14 days' notice of his intention to do so to the applicant for, or holder of such license and the insurer whom he represents or who desires that he be licensed, and shall set a date when the applicant or licensee may appear to be heard and produce evidence. Such notice may be given by registered mail.'
