## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Gloucester.

Town of New Gloucester; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of New Gloucester, the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955, for tuition for children of Opportunity Farm who are being educated in the public schools of New Gloucester; such amount to be paid from the general fund of the state on requisition of the commissioner of education.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are about 35 children of Opportunity Farm who are being taught in the public schools of New Gloucester which creates a heavy financial burden on the town.
