STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE.

AN ACT Relating to Discontinuance of State or State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 7-E, amended. Section 7-E of chapter 20 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 321 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph thereof the following sentences:

'Provided that the state shall pay to such town or county, and such town or county shall expend, the cost of such maintenance, such cost to be the same amount per mile as is expended by the state on state aid highways maintained by the state. The provisions of the preceding sentence shall not apply to minor changes made in the location of state highways to improve the physical characteristics of the highway. Minor changes shall be construed to mean changes made to less than I mile of highway.'
