IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Malt Liquor License Fees in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-F, amended. The last paragraph of section 22-F of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 85 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every applicant for an oiginal or renewal malt liquor license shall remit with his application a filing fee of \$10, except in unorganized places the filing fee of \$10 shall be paid to the county treasurer of the county in which the unincorporated place is located.'
