HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 983, L. D. 1071, Bill "An Act  
Prohibiting Sale of Liquor in Connection  
with Pari Mutuel Betting."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph  
and inserting in place thereof, the following:

'No liquor license of any kind shall be issued to any  
person, partnership, association or corporation conducting  
a pari mutuel betting establishment nor to a grantee,  
licensee, lessee, or concessionaire of such person, partner-  
ship, association or corporation whose premises are upon or  
adjoin or are within 400 yards of the grounds of a licensed  
pari mutuel betting establishment.'
