STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Sale of Liquor in Connection with Pari Mutuel Betting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-E, amened. Section 22-E of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 259 of the public laws of 1949, and as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'No liquor license shall be issued to any person, partnership, association or corporation whose premises are upon or adjoin or are within 500 yards of the grounds of a licensed pari mutuel betting establishment.'
